Invitation to Bid for Resurfacing of Streets

RECEIPT OF PROPOSALS

Sealed Proposals will be received by the Town of Carthage Tennessee, for the Milling and Resurfacing of Streets at the City Hall, Carthage, Tennessee 37030, on or before August 24, 2026 at 10:00 a.m., C.D.T.

Project to include milling and resurfacing listed streets with a 2.0-inch layer of e-mix compacted paving. Preliminary estimates are approximately 172,761 square feet, however, Bidders are responsible for estimating their own quantities. This includes adjusting of manholes and valve boxes to finished pavement height. There will be no striping required for this project. Town of Carthage will retain millings, contractor to haul to designated site on First Avenue West, Carthage, Tennessee.

- Franklin Lane
- Smotherman Ave from Main Street North to Vivian Lane
- Carmack Avenue from Main Street North including section of Hillview Drive and all of Cumberland Drive
- Hull Avenue including a section of Dogwood Street

The envelope containing the proposal must be sealed and plainly marked "Town of Carthage 2026 Paving". The sealed bids, invited by the Town of Carthage, will be received at P. O. Box 259 or 314 Spring Street, Carthage, Tennessee 37030, until August 24, 2026, 10:00 am. C.D.T. at which time they will be opened and publicly read aloud.

Contractors are encouraged to perform a site evaluation.
